HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT: VALUE STILL LIFE - CUPS

OBJECTIVES

- To develop a full range of value (describe volume, form, and texture).
- Effectively demonstrate knowledge of sighting, composition and perspective.

ASSIGNMENT

Use your drawing of 10-12 WHITE Styrofoam or paper cups as a skeleton guidepost for a fully developed, richly textured, detailed contour line drawing of the same space.

1. Use a mylar overlay on top of your original drawing.
2. Begin lightly adding value with vine charcoal. Work *GENERAL* ---> *SPECIFIC* and *LIGHT* --> *DARK*. Work on the entire piece evenly, one step at a time. Failure to do so may require you to start over.
3. Fully develop a visually stimulating *Plastic Value* structure using *Continuous Tone*. Use your value scale as a guide. Make sure the *6 Divisions of Light and Shadow* are evident in your drawing.
4. Demonstrate use of *SHAPE* instead of line.
5. Demonstrate a full range of *EDGE QUALITY*.
6. Every assignment done in charcoal must be spray fixed and accompanied by a newsprint overlay. No exceptions.

Black Charcoal (sticks & pencils)

Chamois or blending stump

Sketchbook

Sighting Stick

Viewfinder & paperclips

Artist's Tape

Ruler
